

# Ivingswood Academy

## PE & Sport Funding Statement

### 2015-2016

Ivingswood Academy understands and values the importance of physical activity and sport. We encourage our children to undertake a range of sports and activities, both within the statutory PE curriculum, as well as in extracurricular time. The Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport have allocated ring-fenced funding to help support the provision of PE sports in schools.

For the academic year 2015-2016 we received £8790. At Ivingswood we decided the following areas were a priority:

- Ensuring high quality first teaching in PE, using specialist coaching in school from Reception to Year 6.
- CPD for teachers to deliver high quality PE.
- Swimming – subsidising the cost of transport to lessons.
- Resourcing areas of the curriculum to ensure that all children are able to take a full part in lessons.
- To provide afterschool clubs
- Extend opportunities for inter-school competition.

Within the school day, Ivingswood encourages learning in all aspects of the PE Curriculum, with all children receiving two planned lessons a week, covering gymnastics, dance, athletics, games, outdoor and adventurous activities and swimming (Adventurous activities and swimming KS2 only). In the last year we have run extra-curricular clubs in the areas of football, netball, rounders, multi sports, cricket and gymnastics. We have also had the opportunity to compete in inter-school competitions such as the county 'Year 6' games.
