**Synonyms are words with the same or similar meaning:**

- Words such as happy, cheerful and merry.
- Words such as sad, miserable and heartbroken.

**Antonyms are words with opposite meanings:**

- Words such as angry and peaceful.
- Words such as funny and serious.
