Activity 3: Read the extract from *The Town Mouse and The Country Mouse* then you can answer the questions either on the sheet if you want to print it out, or straight into your blue books - don't worry about copying out the question, just write your answer, checking that it makes grammatical sense! © Finally, can you think of 3 of your own comprehension questions that you could ask?
