Read this Rainbow poem...

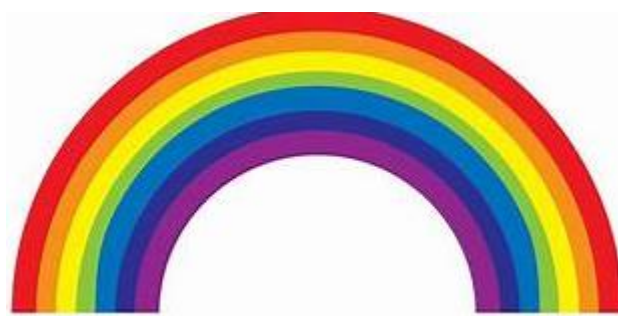


Rainbow.
