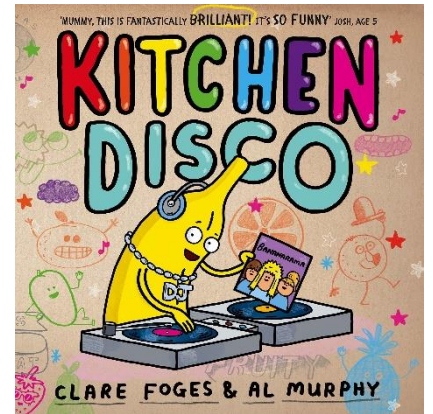


Thursday 2nd July 2020

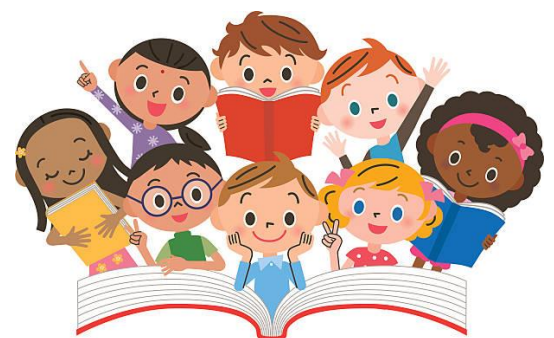


I want you to write your favourite line from the story under your picture. My favourite line is 'So move your hips, shake your pips and let's get all excited!'
