



Curriculum Overview – SPRING TERM – YEAR 2 – Our Wonderful World



Maths

This term we will start with our unit on Money. We will revisit our prior knowledge of coins and notes. We will also learn to add and subtract money. We then will move onto Multiplication and Division. We will add to our knowledge of length and height and finish the term looking at mass, capacity and temperature.

Please remember to use Numbots and White rose 1 minute maths apps at least 3 times a week.



Science

We have two science units this term:

- Habitats
- Animals including humans.

During Habitats we will learn about the difference between living and non-living things, the different habitats and why animals are suited to their habitats. During Animals including humans, we will learn about the life cycles of animals including humans and their diet.

English Writing

This term we will explore a range of texts including narrative, picture stimulus writing and a non-fiction information text.

We will be writing based on the book: 'The Building Boy' by Ross Montgomery and David Litchfield. We will also be writing a non-chronological report based on the book: 'What's Where on Earth Atlas' by Dorling Kindersley Limited.

English Reading

This term, children will be continuing with daily phonics or comprehension lessons. Reading books will be changed 1-2 times a week on different days so please return reading packs to school every day.
