



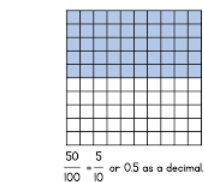
Curriculum Overview – Spring Term – Year 5 – Bean to Bar



Maths

The children will build on their skills from Year 4, looking at place value, written addition and subtraction methods before looking at the relationship between decimals and percentages.

Percentages as fractions and decimals



Science

This term, children will be able to compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, transparency and response to magnets by sorting and classifying materials according to their properties.

English Writing
