



Curriculum Overview – Summer – Year 6 – Crime and Punishment

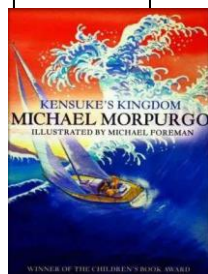


Maths
