Maths

Place Value

- Sequencing, ordering & working with numbers up to 10,000.

Addition & Subtraction

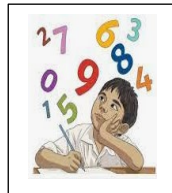
- Calculations with 4-digit numbers, including exchanging.

Measurement

- Finding the area of a shape.

Multiplication & Division

- Using times table facts to solve calculations.



Science

States of Matter

- Solids, liquids, and gases.

Sound

- Investigating pitch, animals' ears, and how sound travels. We will be going on a "sound walk" (date TBC).



English Writing

Writing based on key texts:

- The Iron Man (a science fiction story)
- Sicily (holiday brochure)
- The Whale (a story)

English Reading

- Comprehension skills, including retrieval and inference, based on a range of texts.
