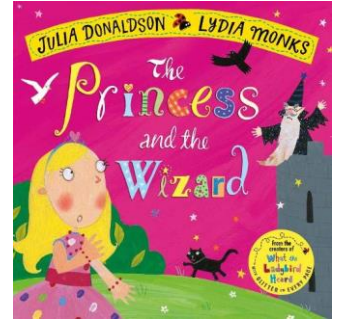


Tuesday 9th June 2020

Good Morning Reception Class,

Yesterday we listened to the story of The Princess and the Wizard. The Princess was able to turn into any shape or colour and become whatever she wanted to while she tried to hide from the Wizard. In your book I would like you to draw, label and colour a picture of what you would turn into if you were trying to hide from the Wizard.
