Here are some things you could try...

Find out how many countries are in Europe and create a page in your topic book about your favourite country. What does the flag look like? How many people live there? What language is spoken the most?

See if you can find different ways to say 'Hello' or 'Good Morning' in different European languages to answer the register with when you come back to school.

A lot of the foods we eat in England comes from different parts of Europe. Mrs Dunton's favourite food is pizza and Mrs Stacey's favourite food is lasagne. They are both from the same country, can you find out where?

Find out where your favourite European food is from and either make or draw a picture of it.
