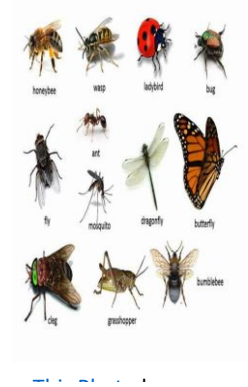


Thursday 23rd April 2020
