The oceans are home to amazing creatures. There are 228,450 known species in the ocean and as many as 2 million that remain a mystery to us. The oceans are made of layers, where the different creatures live.

Unfortunately, the oceans are becoming full of rubbish, especially plastic. Click on the picture below to watch a video about some of the things we could all do to reduce how much plastic we use. Once you have watched this, have a go at making a poster to tell other people about what we can do to help the ocean creatures.



See if you can make your own ocean by recycling a bottle. You will need to use some water, blue food colouring, pebbles and oil.

Instructions

1. Fill half the bottle with water.
2. Add a few drops of blue food colouring.
3. Add the ocean items.
4. Fill the rest of the bottle with oil.
5. Put the lid tightly on the bottle. You might want to ask a grown-up to help you make sure it is sealed tightly. You could add strong tape around the lid, to make sure it is secure.
