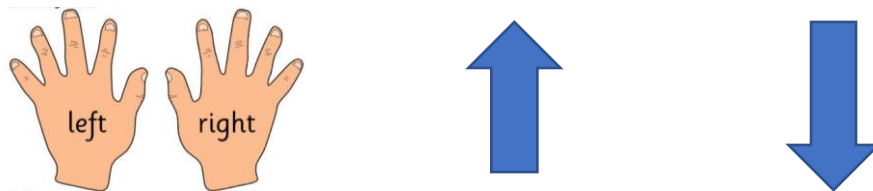

This week we are going to be working on Position and Direction. For today's activities you need to look at the arrows to decide if the items are moving left, right, up, down, forwards or backwards.



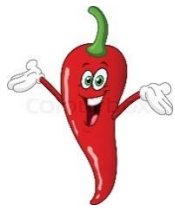

Keep scrolling to get the different maths activities and the English activity for today.

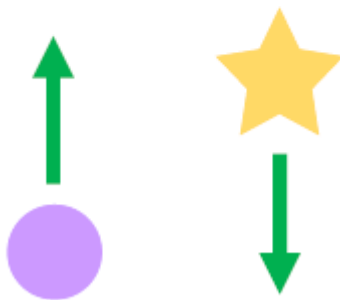


1a. In which direction is the triangle moving?



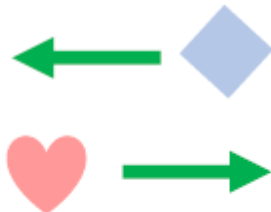

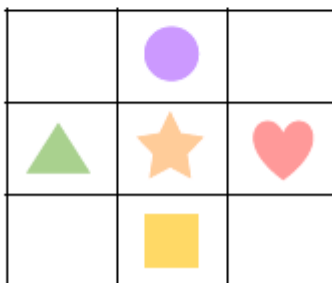

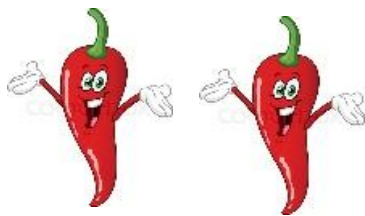

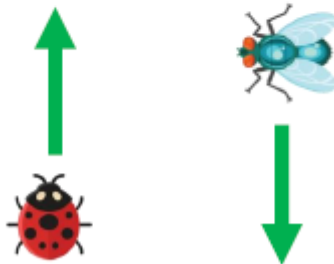

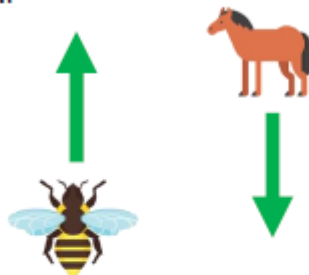

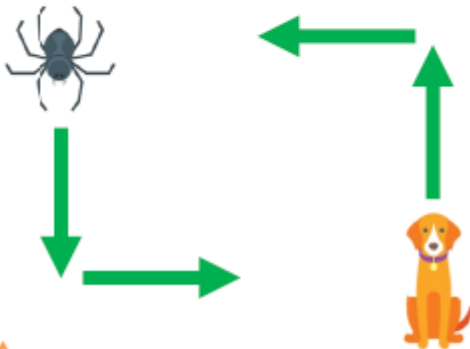
