Maths

As Mrs Swayland's email suggested, the government has provided some online lessons using a school called Oak National Academy. I would like to try their on-line maths lesson today. This is because we are starting a new topic - fractions. The children have learnt about fractions in Year 1 and 2 so they should be familiar with these words: fraction, part, whole, half, quarter, three-quarters. I have watched the first video (from Monday 20th April) and I'd like you to sit with your child to complete this. There is no written recording of this lesson, but plenty of discussion. The focus is vocabulary and a method called, part, part, whole.

The lesson starts and ends with a quiz to see how much your child understands. I will use the website again later in the week and some of the White Rose Maths resources we usually use in school too.
