## Maths

We are continuing our learning on fractions this week and I am so pleased that you managed to complete the work last week. We are learning to find fractions of amounts. If you want to find ½ of something, you divide by 2. If you want to find a ¼ of something you divide by 4. If you want to find 1/5 of something, you divide by 5.

So 1/5 of 20 = (20 divide 5) 4
