Last week we worked on nouns and adjectives (which describe nouns), and today we are learning about adverbs (they describe verbs). Who can remember what the job of a verb is?

## Maths

We are continuing our learning on fractions this week and I am so pleased that you managed to complete the work last week. We are learning to find fractions of amounts. If you want to find  $\frac{1}{2}$  of something, you divide by 2. If you want to find a  $\frac{1}{4}$  of something you divide by 4. If you want to find  $\frac{1}{5}$  of something, you divide by 5.

So  $\frac{1}{5}$  of 20 = (20 divide 5) 4
