For example: Sarah's bed is all messy. The children decided that Tom's painting was the best.

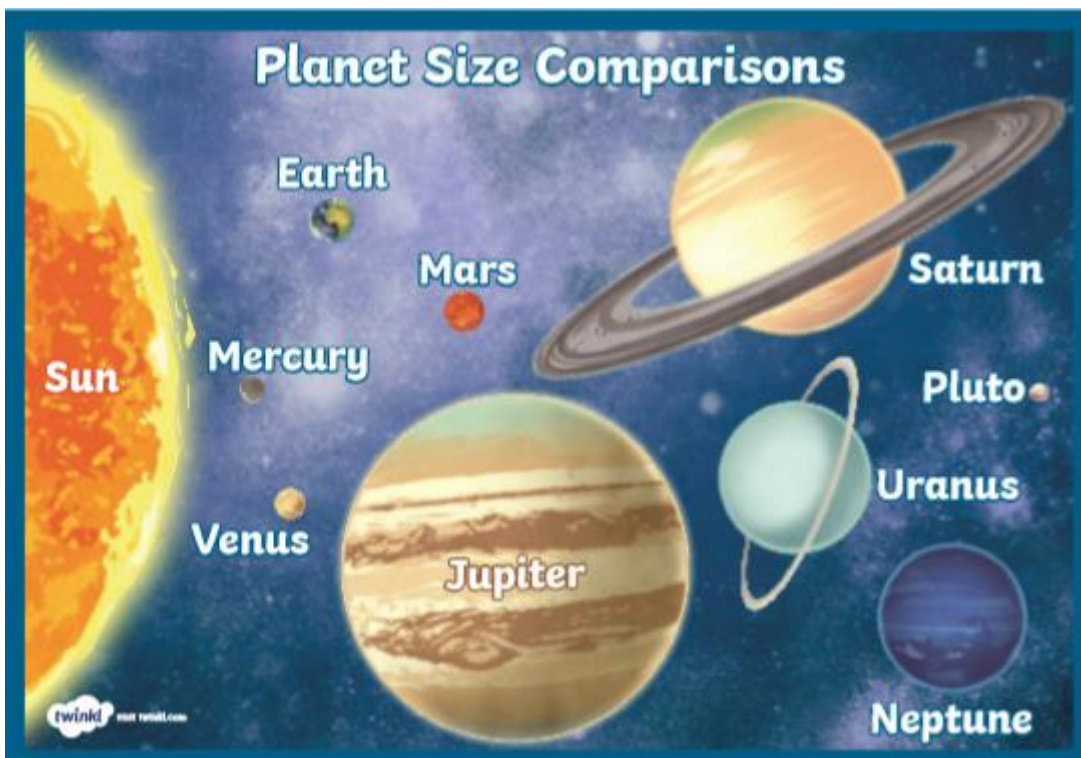
