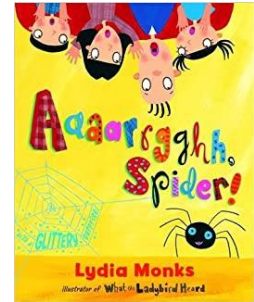


Friday 15th May 2020
