A sequence is made up of three 2-digit numbers.

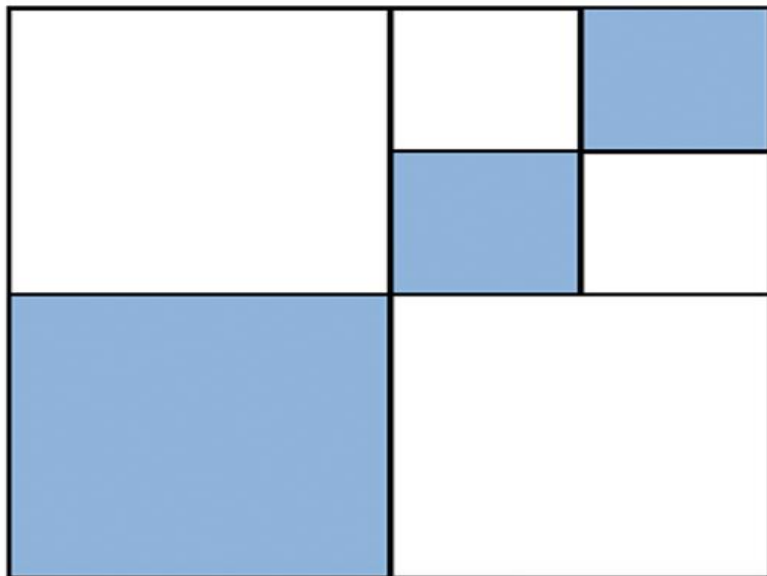
The sequence increases by eight each time. These are the digits that make up the three numbers.
