



## EYFS Topic Home Learning

<b>Topic:</b>	
<b>We will learn about:</b>	How fruit and vegetables grow
<b>Words we can use:</b>	Fruit, vegetable, growing, seeds, water sunlight, soil, plants, trees, orchards, allotments
<b>Questions we can ask:</b>	What do fruit and vegetables need to grow? Where do vegetables grow? Where does fruit grow? Could we grow our own fruit and vegetables?
<b>Activity:</b>	Look at home to see which fruits and vegetables you have in your home. Sort them into 2 piles, one for fruit and one for vegetables and see if you can name them all.
