Today for English please look at yesterday's lesson: Tuesday 12th May - it's all about using similes and metaphors. We have used these a lot in our writing this year, and I know you did last year as well. Remember, a simile is when you compare two things and say something is **'like'** something else, for example, as quick as a flash, as tall as a house, as dark as night. A metaphor is when you say something **'is'** something else - but it isn't really, you're just being descriptive, for example pitch black, lightning quick, candyfloss clouds.
